Morikami Museum and Japanese Gardens

Tucked away in the midst of sand and palm trees of southern Florida there's an oasis of Japanese beauty and tranquility. The Morikami Museum and Japanese Gardens in Delray Beach does more than delight visitors with its introduction to and celebration of the art and culture of Japan.

Morikami is the only setting, worldwide, to exhibit a historical view of authentic Japanese-style gardens. These gardens are ranked eighth in quality among more than 300 Japanese Gardens outside Japan. The gardens encompass sixteen acres composed of six different historic garden styles that demonstrate periods of Japanese garden history and design from the 8th to the 20th century.
